The Space

Situated in Costa Smeralda this Lounge matches once again iconic products with the recent proposals of the furniture brand, which share with Lamborghini the typical Italian spirit, beauty and heritage. At the entrance, the visitor is welcomed by the area dedicated to the Heritage Wall which shows the Islands storage unit. Designed by Stephen Burks, it is accessible on various sides thanks to the perimeter of wooden slats mounted with apparent randomness that, turning on themselves, now create a compact presence, now an airy element, for different interpretations of the same product, always conveying a taste of refined craftsmanship. Perfect for a relaxing break to enjoy even in company, the Nina stools lightly parade in the Counter Bar. Protagonists of the Living Area, the Sumo armchairs designed by Piero Lissoni are paired with the Oolong seat and the Moon Coffee Table, proposed in two different variants, Eclipse and Full Moon. Among the complementary furniture, the Graft table accompanies the experience of the car configurator inside the AD Personam Room, surrounded by the Maja D chairs. Lastly, the Agra upholstery family by Spanish designer David Lopez Quincoces furnishes the Backyard, both in the sofa and armchair versions, together with the Ile coffee tables, in the outdoor version.
